You can go down or across

These four birds are all extinct in New Zealand. You are searching for their bones in a cave. See if you can find them before your partner.

Shade in squares for the bones of the bird that your partner will look for. Try to find your partners' bones by calling out five numbers. Mark them on your sheet to show a find or a miss. Then your partner has five chances. When they call out a number, tell them if they got a "find" or a "miss" for that number. If it is a find tell them what kind of bird they have started to find. Keep swapping till one person finds all the bones.
